REGULATIONS, GUIDELINES, ELIGIBILITY, SELECTION 2011

- * Closing date for applicants to register is June 15th, 2011.
- * Applications are to be sent by mail, fax or e-mail to the attention of the Education Awards Committee no later than the due date with full mailing address on the cover sheet.
- * Owners, full time employees, spouses or dependents of Members of A.O.P.A. in good standing are eligible to apply.
- * Those eligible must be a resident of New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia or Newfoundland.
- * Applicant must attend a registered University, College or Community College.
- * Eligibility of applicants will be determined by the Education Awards Committee whose decisions will be final.
- * Only one award per family per calendar year will be permitted.
- * For 2011, a minimum of 6 awards of \$500.00. One award which is the Bill Todd Memorial for \$500.00
- * Payment of the awards will be made to the student and the institution jointly for the second semester of the year in January 2012.
- * A random draw will be made from a box containing the names of all applicants eligible.
- * Selection of 2011 candidates/winners will be made at the Annual Lobster Social in Prince Edward Island on June 17-19, 2011.
- * Applicants need not be in attendance, but are encouraged.
- * Award cheques will be given to the Member company/firm for presentation to the winning applicant.
Note - cheques will be made out to both the applicant and the institution they are attending.
